



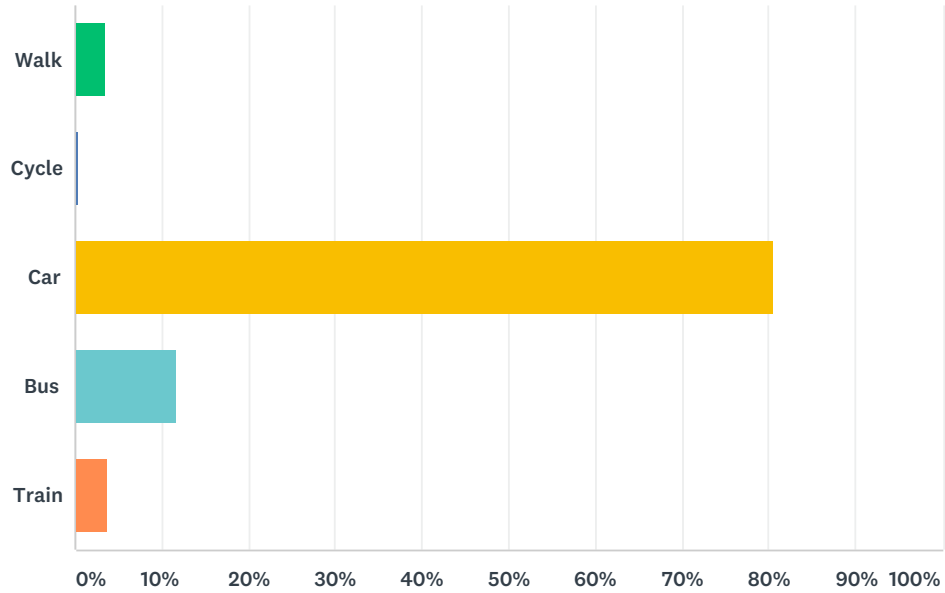

Q1 How do you mainly travel?

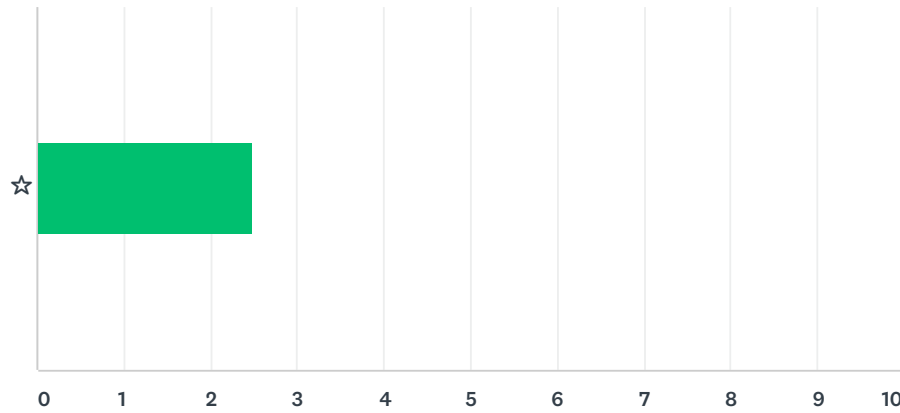

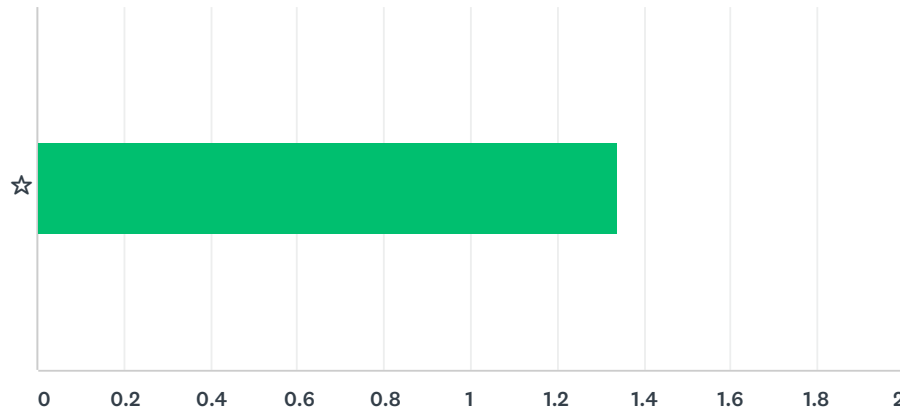

Q3 On a scale of 1-5 (1 being never and 5 being most frequent) how often do you travel by cycling?

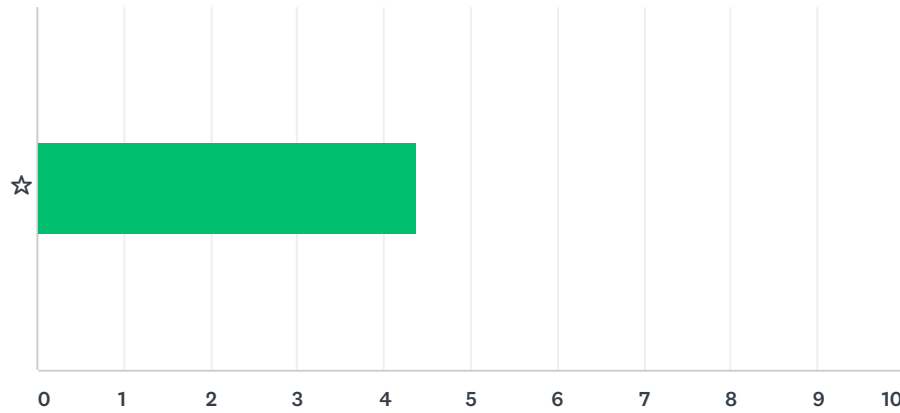

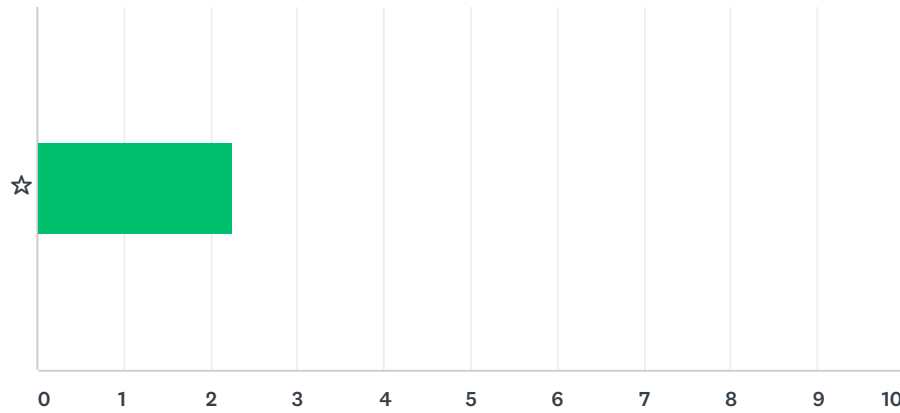

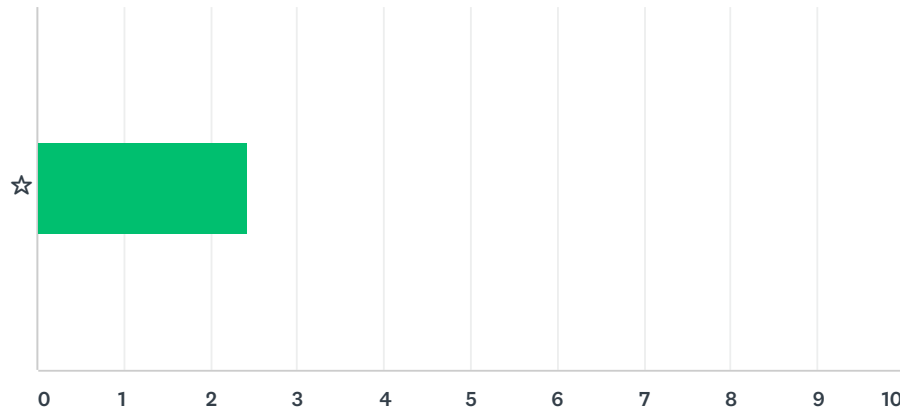

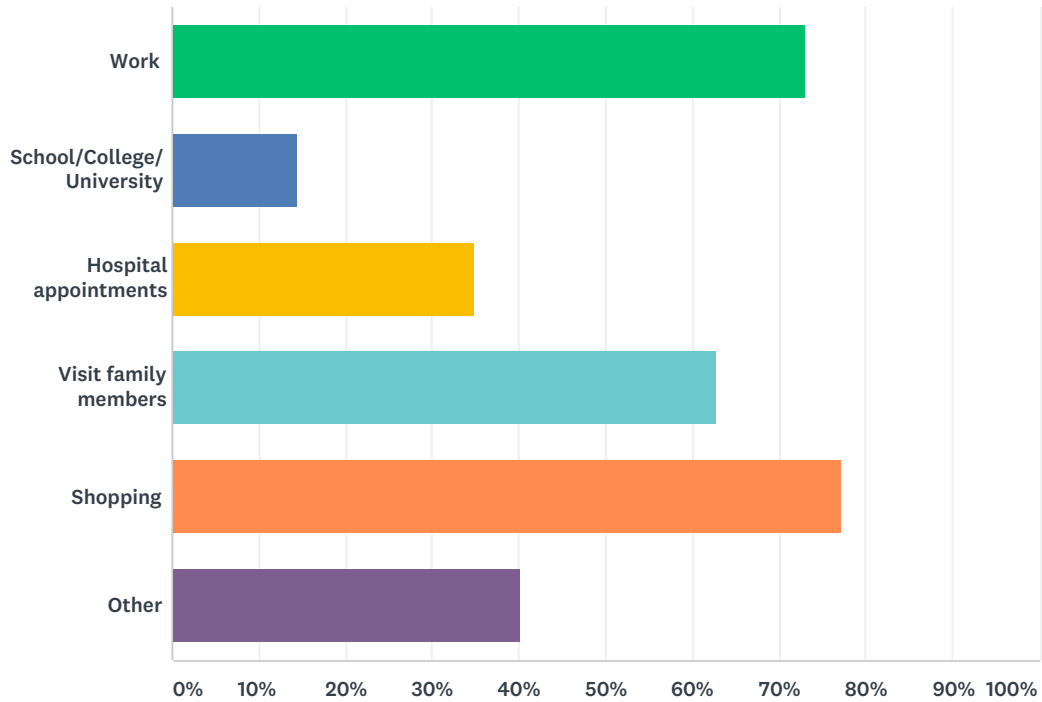

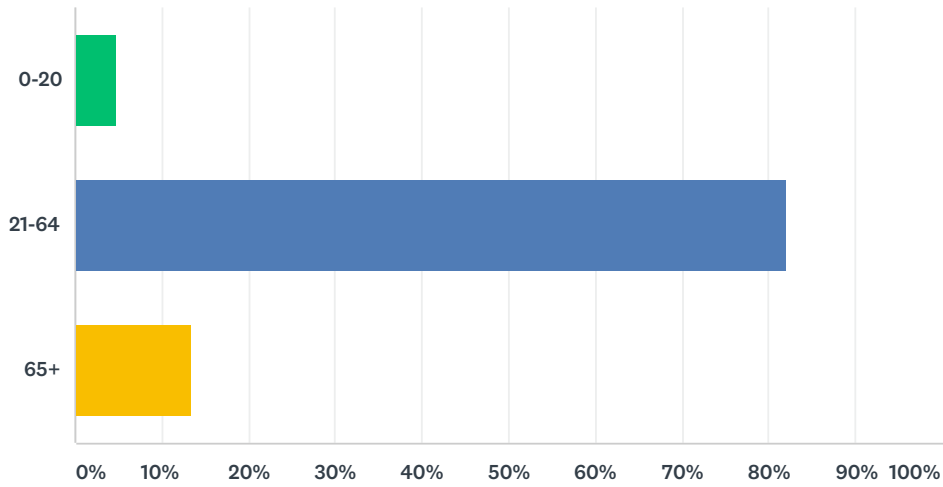
